

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)
Regarding the Wolf Canyon Re-Opening Plan

What happens during the week of April 5th for students?

Students will remain with their current teacher and continue to participate in Distance Learning. Daily schedules will be modified to allow time for teachers to prepare for re-opening and new class rosters.

My child will continue to participate in the Distance Learning Program. Will there be any changes to the schedule? Will my child have the same teacher?

The daily instructional schedule should remain fairly consistent. There may be some time changes for when students participate in art and music lessons. There will be some changes to teacher assignments based on providing two different program models for students. You will receive notification of class assignments the week of April 5th.

Will Hybrid Program students still have art and music classes?

Yes, students will participate in art and music during the asynchronous minutes of their school day. Students in the AM cohort will participate in the afternoon and students in the PM cohort will participate in the morning.

My child is currently enrolled in the DLSP (Distance Learning Support Program), when will he/she attend the Hybrid Program?

DLSP students will attend the PM hybrid program from 12:30 – 3:15 p.m.

What will the hours of the DLSP program be during the Hybrid Program?

The DLSP hours will remain the same during the Hybrid Program.

DLSP hours are 7:30 a.m. - 4 p.m.

I have responded to the survey but would like to change my mind, is that possible?

Yes, you may make changes by notifying your child's teacher no later than 3:30 p.m. on March 25th. Changes that are requested after this date will be honored if space permits.

I don't have a preference for the Hybrid Program or Distance Learning Program, however I want my child to remain with his/her teacher. How do I make this request?

Please notify your child's teacher regarding your request no later than 3:30 p.m. on March 25th.

If a child is sent home ill, can they attend the Distance Learning Program during their quarantine period?

Students will receive asynchronous work from their Hybrid teacher during their quarantine time.

Will COVID testing be provided on campus?

Students and Staff may participate in a voluntary testing program on campus every two weeks. Families will have the opportunity to schedule appointment times. More information will be provided in April.

What happens to the Hybrid Program if the County of San Diego returns to the purple tier after schools are re-opened?

Schools will be allowed to remain open for the Hybrid Program.

When does the Hybrid Program end?

The last day of the 2020-2021 school year will be June 15th for all students in the Hybrid Program and Distance Learning Program.
